

ANNEX EEE : COVID-19 ETP for INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING travel.

As of 8 May 2020

COVID-19 mitigation measures impacted the ability to train Soldiers across the Institutional Training base. Further updates to ANNEX EEE will occur as the operational environment becomes more permissive and the Army can continue to protect the force. Check ATRRS for class start/report dates. Dates do not include 14-day isolation and schoolhouses may isolate prior to start dates, or some may isolate during the course, after the start date. Schoolhouses will manage the isolation time. Coordinate with gaining schoolhouse for details.

The courses listed as Initial Military Training/Initial Entry Training support the Army's Accession mission and will not require an Exception To Policy (ETP) for travel to or from training and to first unit of assignment (FUA).

PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION

The courses listed below are Professional Military Education (PME) and Functional courses that TRADOC will start to train again in May/June 2020. Attendance to these courses in a TDY status that begins within the stop move window will require a case-by-case Exception To Policy (ETP) for travel to training by their owning ACOM or ASCC Commanding General or an HQDA Principal Official in accordance with the current SECARMY travel policy (Annex PPP). Soldiers conducting a permanent change of station (PCS) to attend PME require an exception to policy signed by the Under Secretary of the Army or Vice Chief of Staff of the Army, in accordance with current SECARMY travel policy (Annex PPP). SMs in a Joint Command or Service Specific Command, not under the authority of the SECARMY, will follow procedures outlined by their owning Department or Command.

- U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy (SMC) Non-Resident: Resident Phase Class 03 and 04 will utilize DL means to complete the remainder of course work.
- Delay Resident SMC Class 71 and CGSOC Class of 2021 to NET 8 September 2020.
- Start Resident SMC Class 71 in the fall with maximum students available. Students unable to move, start with virtual learning and if conditions permit, join the resident class in January 2021.
- CGSOC Class will start in the fall. It will be divided into two populations.
 - One being 2/3rds of the class PCS for the Resident Class (PCS population).
 - The second 1/3 of the class will be doing full time DL assigned to the student detachment as full time students as their primary duty and then in January 2021 they will travel TDY to Leavenworth to join the other 2/3rd (PCS population) for the completion of the Residence Course.
 - Intermediate-Level Education (ILE) (Resident): Students currently enrolled will complete via Blackboard.
 - Intermediate-Level Education (SATELLITE): Students currently enrolled in the satellite would remain at home station and complete ILE in a blended fashion, using a blend of existing distance learning courseware, faculty facilitation and instruction via blackboard.

STRATEGIC EDUCATION

The Army War College, Resident Education Program (REP) AY20, will graduate on time (on 5 June 2020). Current resident class completed term II electives, strategic research projects and oral comprehensive exams, as scheduled; the term III electives continue virtually, with flexibility in scheduling, as needed.

- Resident Education Program class of AY21 anticipated arriving on time in July – August 2020. Preparing to start class distributed if needed.
- USAWC Fellowship Program: no change to current July report dates for Fellows at Carlisle barracks for in processing and orientation. Continuing to monitor host institution planning for arrival of students/fellows, as per local authority guidance.
- Distance Education Program class, AY20 – 22, orientation courses will be conducted via virtual means.
- Distance Education Program Resident Course at Carlisle Barracks, PA: No change to dates for AY19 – 21, first resident course, in June 2020 and AY18 – 20, second resident course July 2020. Planning continues to conduct virtually, if needed.
- Basic Strategic Arts Program (BSAP): April BSAP class 20A graduation was accelerated; May BSAP class 20B delayed until 18 May 2020 with a virtual/remote start and continued planning for a delayed arrival of students between 21 June 2020 and 05 July 2020.
- Army Strategic Education Program (ASEP): regularly scheduled courses have been cancelled or postponed resulting in numerous changes to when individual general officers can attend required professional military education (as directed by NDAA19).
- April 2020 ASEP–C course postponed until 13 – 17 July 2020.
- May 2020 ASEP–S course postponed until 27 – 31 July 2020.
- May 2020 ASEP–T course will deliver via virtual means.
