MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: USASD Soldiers Local Area leave and Travel Restrictions

1. References.

2. Effective immediately, all DoD Service members assigned to the United States Army Student Detachment will adhere to the following leave and pass restrictions:


a. Soldier that do not have a GO or SES in their immediate chain of supervision will limit movement to local area defined as a 100-mile radius from the Soldier's assigned duty station or personal residence and are only authorized to take local leave / pass at their Soldier's primary residence. Requests for exceptions will be submitted through the U.S. Army Student Detachment and Leader Training Brigade to the undersigned for approval.

b. Soldiers who have a GO or SES in their immediate chain of supervision will adhere to their local area travel restrictions and process leave and pass exceptions through that local flag level chain of supervision.

3. This memo supercedes the USASD Soldiers Local Area / PCS Leave and Travel Restrictions memo dtd 9 Jun 20.

4. These leave and travel restrictions remain in effect until rescinded.
