MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Local Area leave and Travel Restrictions

1. References.

- c. ALARACT 054/2020 – Consolidated Personnel Policy Guidance In Support Of Conditions-Based Phased Approach To Army-Wide Preparedness And Response To Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak (dtd 12 JUN 20)
- d. AR 600-20 - Command Policy (dtd 6 NOV 14)

2. Effective immediately, leave travel for DoD Service members is exempt from the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) travel restrictions with the following caveat. Approval for leave and pass outside the local area is withheld to the battalion commander or higher level. Local leave may be approved at a level no lower than the company, battery, or detachment commander IAW AR 600-8-10.


3. Leave approval authorities will conduct a risk assessment of the health status and travel itinerary for Soldiers requesting leave. Commanders and supervisors will establish a means of communication with all Soldiers throughout the period of leave and the post-travel process, as well as prescribing actions for their particular circumstances

4. Soldiers will comply with any DoD, federal, state, and local restrictions while in a leave status.

5. For United States Army Student Detachment Soldier's assigned to remote sites not affiliated with a DoD installation or DoD school, the local area is defined as a 250-mile radius from the Soldier's duty assignment / location or personal residence. United States Army Student Detachment Soldier's assigned with duty at other DoD installations or institutions will adhere to their local leave / pass definitions, policies, and processes.

6. This memo supersedes the USASD Soldiers Local Area / PCS Leave and Travel Restrictions memo dtd 12 Jun 20.
